The Choice of Court Agreements Act came into force on 1 October 2016.

The Act implements the 2005 Hague Convention on Choice of Court Agreements, which Singapore ratified on 2 June 2016. It was passed in Parliament on 14 April 2016.

The Act enhances the enforceability of Singapore judgments abroad and strengthens Singapore's position as an international dispute resolution hub.
